The Cowplain School has developed a vibrant curriculum to suit the needs of all learners. A Supporting Achievement Team addresses any pastoral issues and works alongside the passionate and committed team of teaching and support staff. Students take part in reflective time each day

with their tutors; there is a value based ethos across the school and the mindfulness programme encourages students to be reflective and resilient in their learning.

Students can complement their learning through trips and activities, both at home and abroad. Cowplain holds Artsmark Gold status in recognition of its excellent Arts provision, winning numerous awards at Rock Challenge 2016 for the performance The Trigger, and offers an extensive extra-curricular enrichment programme.

The Cowplain School has a reputation for caring passionately about its students; class sizes are kept small and the transition programme from primary to secondary school has

been recognised as excellent. The Learning Support department offers individually tailored programmes for students with specific learning difficulties whilst a Gifted and Talented Coordinator supports able and ambitious students to ensure they fulfil their potential.
