## RSHE in Year 11

As a part of your child's education at The Cowplain School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE). RSHE is the curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

From October, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus specifically on the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) aspect of the programme. RSE lessons in Year 11 will include teaching about healthy relationships and communication skills; maintaining sexual health; families and parenting; fertility, adoption and abortion; pregnancy and miscarriage and health promotion, including self-examination. Students will have opportunities to ask questions in a safe environment that helps prepare them for relationships of all kinds in the modern world.

RSHE is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and Academy Trust. All RSHE teaching takes place in a safe environment, is taught in an age-appropriate manner, and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.
